## SECTION 53 OF THE WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 COUNTY OF DEVON DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL (FOOTPATH Nos. 11, 20 and 21, PAYHEMBURY) DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2021

The above Order has been made and, if confirmed, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by **adding** to them:

**Footpath Nos. 20, 21 and 11 (part)** in the parish of Payhembury, as shown on plan HIW/PROW/20/23, from the county road at Witness Moor to Hembury Fort. And also by **deleting** part of Footpath No. 11 at Hembury Fort, as shown on the same plan.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to the Public Rights of Way Service, Great Moor House, Bittern Road, Sowton, Exeter EX2 7NL, not later than 1<sup>st</sup> March 2023 and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made. Copies of any objections or representations received may be circulated to interested parties.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or if any so made are withdrawn, Devon County Council may, instead of submitting the Order, themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
