

## Payhembury Neighbourhood Plan Consultation 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2016

A parish community fair took place on 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2016. There was a “Neighbourhood Plan” stand adjacent to the Parish Council stand. The event was used to introduce the concept of a neighbourhood plan to the community and to collect comments on what those attending would like to see covered in the plan. The intention is to use this information to set the scope of the plan. An advertising mailshot for the event itself, and the Neighbourhood Plan stand in particular, had been delivered to properties in the parish in advance. The event was well attended with more than 100 people passing through the fair and circa 40 people actively engaging with the Neighbourhood Plan stand. The scene setting question of “What should Payhembury look like in 2030?” was asked with sub-questions “What is good about Payhembury?”, “What would you like to see change?”, “What makes Payhembury a good place to live/work in?”, “What pressures affect the area?”. Those attending were asked to write responses on ‘post-it’ notes. All of the responses are listed below.
