Reporting blocked ditches, flooding etc.

Recently there have been a number of problems with blocked ditches causing localised flooding. Devon County Council have cleared some of these ditches in the past, but they advise that the responsibility for keeping ditches clear lies with the owner of the land, not with them and that they no longer have the budget to clear these ditches. However, they ask that you still report blocked ditches to them so that they can chase the relevant landowner to clear them - https://www.devon.gov.uk/roads-and-transport/maintaining-roads/managing-the-network/flooding-and-drainage/report-standing-water-flooding-or-blocked-drains/.

If you find any issues of blocked drains, flooding etc can you let the relevant landowner know and, if appropriate, help to clear the problem. Hopefully, by doing this, we can reduce the number of floods and the inconvenience caused.

Parish Council grants awarded – January 2024

Road closures – February 2024

The following road closures are scheduled for February 2024, diversions should be in place if needed:

- <u>12th 16th February 2024 Road from Colestocks Cross (by Shutes Barn) to Payhembury Road</u> DCC drainage work. This will disrupt access to and from Feniton.
- 13th February 2024 Road from Blue Anchor Cross to Tuckmill Cross BT pole replacements
- <u>19th February 8th March 2024 Road from Colliton Cross (A373) to Haskins Cross</u> some underground cabling works and tree-cutting required to assist with extensive overhead cabling (BT). This will disrupt access to the A373.
- **29th February 2024** Road from the telephone box towards Upton Installation of sewer level equipment in the man hole (SWW)
